

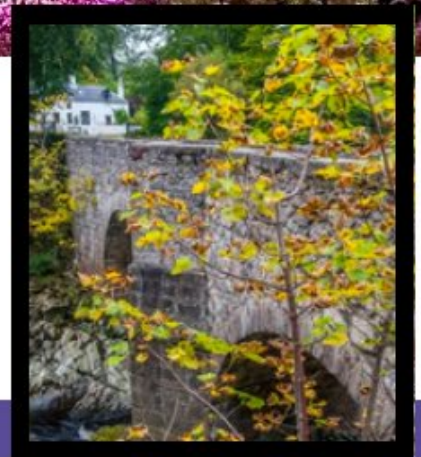

What is a Community Action Plan?

A Community Action Plan is a document created by a community to outline its goals, priorities, and the actions needed for enhancing the local area. It serves as a roadmap for community-led development, providing clear, actionable steps to address the community's needs, solve problems, and achieve long-term improvements in the well-being of the people living there.

The focus of a Community Action Plan is to engage residents and stakeholders, identify local issues and opportunities, and create a shared vision for the future of the community. Examples of initiatives a Community Action Plan might propose include improving public transport, expanding broadband access, upgrading public services, refurbishing community spaces, and promoting more events and activities.
